


# LOOOOP



## PERFORMANCE CONDITIONS AND STAGE DIRECTIONS FOR FIRE SHOWS

The following performance conditions and stage directions are guidelines. These may vary from one event to the next and should be coordinated individually.

- DURATION**    **15 minutes** optionally longer or shorter
- PERFORMERS**    **3** The show is also possible as a solo or duo.
- STAGE**    The stage should measure at least **6m in depth x 8m wide x 4m interior height**.  
Smaller stages are also possible by arrangement or for solos and duo performances.  
The stage area should be level, non-slip and cleared of all easily flammable materials. Raised stages are ideal. However, if necessary, we can also perform on other surfaces such as concrete, lawn or similar. If required, a carpet should be laid.
- LIGHT**    The stage area should be as dark as possible. Light sources should be switched off or covered during the show.  
However, stage lighting can be used to great atmospheric effect during a fire show.  
**Coloured stage lighting (e.g. pink, red, violet, blue)** and dimmable spotlights are desirable.
- AUDIO**    The event organiser should provide a **suitable sound system for the event** and a sound technician to operate it. If necessary, a sound system can be hired.
- BACKSTAGE**    The event organiser should provide a **heated and lit room** where we can change and prepare for the show. In addition, an area close to the stage should be cordoned off for storing and preparing the fire equipment.  
The event organiser shall provide **catering** for the performers.
- PARKING**    If requested the event organiser shall obtain any necessary transit or parking permits or reserve a **parking space for a vehicle**.
- SAFETY**    Thanks to its many years of stage experience and the constant exchange of information with the international fire performance scene, LOOOOP is qualified to ensure optimum compliance with safety standards.  
The performers only use highly pure lamp oil in order to keep the formation of smoke and odours to a minimum. The fire equipment is made of high-quality materials and is inspected before each performance. During the show, the equipment is professionally extinguished using carefully placed fire blankets.  
Each performer has taken out professional risk indemnity insurance that is specifically designed for this activity and is secured by adequate cover for property damage and personal injury.  
Adequate ventilation must be ensured for indoor fire shows. Smoke alarms must be deactivated during the performance. **The event organiser shall provide fire extinguishers and shall ensure that the show is not prohibited by official or other regulations.**
